Oct 9 - 6 pm Teen Challenge Training Center, Rehrersburg, PA**

This presentation is for the approximately 200 residents in the addiction rehabilitation program at Teen Challenge. We will have an opportunity to meet with some residents in our discipleship small groups. This is our 17th appearance at the Training Center and is also open to the general public.

Oct 23 Northwestern Academy Boot Camp, Coal Twp, PA

The residents of Northwestern are delinquent teenage males who have been placed there by courts throughout Pennsylvania. The Boot Camp is a program for those who have shown promise for successful rehabilitation.

Nov 11, 12 Rikers Island, New York City, NY

Rikers Island is New York City's prison system. It is the largest prison facility in the US, housing over 13,000 inmates. We will be doing ministry in two of the 10 Rikers facilities. This is Shining Light's sixth ministry visit to the Robert. N. Davoren Center and the second to the Eric M. Taylor Center. Previous audiences have numbered 200-300 at each presentation.

Dec 11 Glen Mills Schools

This is our third appearance at Glen Mills. This secure facility houses approximately 400 juvenile males placed there by courts throughout Pennsylvania and other states. In 2011, the week after we offered our presentation over 40 young men made commitments to Christ!

Jan 15 - 6 pm New Life for Girls, Dover, PA**

New Life is a Christian long-term addiction rehabilitation program for women. Our small groups again will have interaction time with residents. This event is open to the public.

Jan 29 Northwestern Academy Intensive Secure Unit

This unit of Northwestern is for the most challenging youth in the correctional system. The most serious offenders and those who have not done well in other facilities are placed here. It is our 8th presentation in this unit because of the tremendous response of the audience to the presentation. This is typically one of the most rewarding and effective presentations of the season.

We will do the Sunday morning Chapel Service for over 1,000 junior and senior high school students in Founders Hall.
