Have you been able to make connections with mentors and team members on the outside? If so, how have you accomplished this?

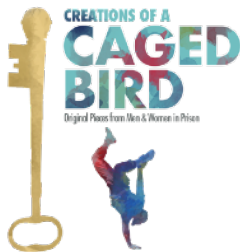
Are there other contacts you hope to make in order to establish the kind of support network Gary describes?
